considered the application of the applicant and found that the defendant has acted in an anti-social manner that caused or was likely to cause harassment, alarm or distress to one or more persons not of the same household as himself and that this order is necessary to protect persons from further anti-social acts by the defendant DAVID STEPHENS

and the court ordered that

The defendant is forbidden (whether by himself or by instructing or encouraging any other person) from:-

1. Engaging in conduct or inciting others to engage in conduct that causes or is likely to cause a nuisance or annoyance to persons residing in or visiting Columbus Street, Wigan
2. Upon service of this order, entering or attempting to enter the area edged red and referred to on the plan attached known as Ashton-in-Makerfield, Wigan (if the Defendant is within the area edged red at the time of service, he must leave the area immediately and not return)
3. Using abusive, insulting or threatening behaviour against Karen Janet Kennedy, formerly of 18 Columbus Street Wigan
4. Using or threatening violence against the said Karen Janet Kennedy.
